WOMAN ARCHITECT OF THE YEAR

ENTRY GUIDELINES

This award recognises excellence in design, thought leadership and being a role model for aspiring architects, with an emphasis on achievements in 2014.

Entrants to this award must be qualified architects but other than that the criteria is open. You may be running your own practice, working on site, in a design-led practice or a large commercial firm.

Last year Mecanoo's Francine Houben was recognised with the accolade. The Dutch architect, who founded her practice in 1984, had completed one of Mecanoo's highest-profile UK projects, the £193 million Library of Birmingham.

Previous winners have also included Michal Cohen and Cindy Walters, founders of Walters and Cohen and award-winning housing architect Alison Brooks.

The judges reserve the right to move entrants between categories.

Deadline

28 November 2014

Conditions

- The award is open to applications from architects, sole practitioners and women-led practices
- Applicants can nominate themselves for the award, or someone else

What you will need to submit

There is no specific entry form for this award. Please submit a Word or PDF document with the following:

- Name of nominee
- Contact details of person submitting the entry – including a daytime telephone number
- Nomination statement – a maximum 300-word statement outlining the nominee's current work and practice
- Images and descriptions of selected projects. Any images sent should be copyright free and high resolution (300dpi at A4 size, to a maximum size of 10MB)
