ENTRY GUIDELINES

This annual award recognises excellence in design with an emphasis on a built project completed in 2016. Candidates must be qualified architects in their country of study. You may be running your own practice, in a small design-led practice or a large commercial firm, in partnership or a director. Joint entries are also accepted.

Jeanne Gang, founder of Studio Gang, was recognised with the accolade for the Arcus Center for Social Justice Leadership in Michigan. Previous winners have included: Pollard Thomas Edwards' Teresa Borsuk; Mecanoo's Francine Houben; Michál Cohen and Cindy Walters, founders of Walters & Cohen; and ABA founder, Alison Brooks.

The judges reserve the right to move entrants between categories

- Contact details of person submitting the entry - including a daytime telephone number
- Nomination statement - an approximately 200-word statement outlining the nominee's current work and practice
- Images and descriptions of selected projects. Any images sent should be copyright free and high resolution (300dpi at A4 size, to a maximum size of 10MB)
